

Positions for Fall 2010 in Berry Crop Entomology

The Berry Crop Entomology Lab at MSU has positions for full time (40h/wk) or part time (20h/week) field research assistants for Fall 2010. Work will involve trips in MSU vehicles to research sites in Southwest Michigan. Interest in and basic knowledge of insects, biology and/or agriculture will be helpful. The person(s) chosen for this position will assist researchers with field work in studies dealing with natural enemies, pollinators and insect pests in blueberry fields and grape vineyards in southwest Michigan. Candidates must be enthusiastic and self-motivated, willing to work flexible hours, enjoy working outside, have a good driving record, and be able to work independently. Applicants should have 2 to 5 weekdays/week when all day travel to field sites is possible. There will also be some work in the lab sorting samples and identifying pest and beneficial insects.
