1. Thursdays 2:45-4:15 Sexton High School--Entrepreneurship
The programs will run the week of February 8 thru the 1st week of May. A field trip may be scheduled for the conclusion of the program (depending on budget). The wage for this program is \$10.50/hour. The time allotted includes the 90 minutes scheduled for the program, 30 minutes total for preparation/clean-up on the program day, and lesson planning preparation (up to 1-hour/week). After school staff will need to complete the county HR process, 4-H Volunteer Selection Process, and will complete short orientation during the planning time for week-1 of the program.
2. Thursdays 4-5 Whitehills Elementary School--Environmental Education/Civic Engagement
Ingham County 4-H has an intern opportunity available working with elementary school students in the area of environmental education & civic engagement. The intern would work directly with teachers in the school to provide 4-H programming during February--June. The program will be Thursdays from 4-5 p.m. The intern will receive \$10.50/hour; and work 2.5 hours/week (1 hour program, .5 set up/clean up, and 1 hour planning).
