Karl Schroff was a broker who helped many flowerbulb companies for more than 50 years to get their products into the United States. Schroff died Oct. 22, 2003 at age 81. Many people involved in the bulb trade have fond memories of Schroff. His helpfulness, personality and business sense won the heart of all who met him. Schroff was knowledgeable about the flowerbulb business and made frequent trips to Holland to visit customers and educate them about the import process.
