**Start testing for your CLT-E in June with the written portion of the test. Next comes the field test in August!**

The Illinois Landscape Contractors Association (ILCA) develops and maintains active programs to enhance the skills of our members and nonmembers. The Landscape Industry Certified Technician-Exterior program is one of those programs.

More towns are putting "CLT on staff" in their bidding requirements. More CLT's will be needed. Now is the time to be ready. You can start the testing or retake those couple tests you missed the last time it was offered.

Landscape Industry Certified testing dates are scheduled for:

- June 16, 2010 – Written Exams (all modules – new applications and retakes)
- August 21, 2010 – Field Exams (all modules – new applications and retakes)
- October 15, 2010 – Written Exams (all modules – new applications and retakes)
