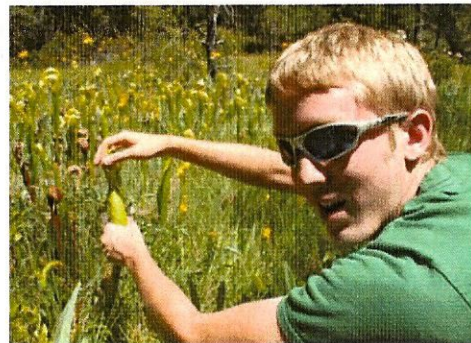

The nursery program is supported by extension faculty specializing in the following areas: soils and soilless substrate, fertility, irrigation, plant pathology, entomology and Christmas trees.

**Sample projects include:**

- Testing an automated nursery irrigation monitoring system
- Deploying automatic caliper measuring technology
- Plant evaluations of xeriscape varieties for the PNW
- Trialing new alternative substrates for container nurseries
